ROYALTY ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Registration form must be completed and turned in no later than **Friday, May 3, 2019**, this will allow us to prepare the Royalty numbers, score cards, and send the classroom evaluations to appropriate teachers
Due to lost registration forms in the past at the Abi school, we ask that you please do not send the registration form in with your child, or stuff it in a backpack. We kindly ask that you, the parent and/or guardian, hand-deliver the completed registration form to the front desk personnel at the Abinoojiiyag School.
2. Contestants must be enrolled at Nay Ah Shing/Pine Grove Schools for one full semester prior to date of powwow
3. Contestants must do well academically and represent Nay Ah Shing/Pine Grove Schools as a positive role model at all times
**Grades, attendance, and behavior will be reviewed on a quarterly basis with all teaching staff*
4. Contestants must be in full regalia
5. Contestants will earn points based on four (4) criteria: speech in Ojibwe, dancing ability, regalia, and academics > scored by classroom teachers
Mandatory attendance and in full regalia at all Nay Ah School powwows, the Mille Lacs Band Traditional Powwow, Grand Casino Hinckley Grand Celebration powwow, Chiminising Youth powwow (Isle), Mille Lacs Memorial Day pow wow (Mille Lacs Indian Museum), Gii-iskonigewag powwow (East Lake)
6. Nay Ah Shing School Ojibwemowin Enokijig will contribute three \$200.00 stipends to assist in attending (3) additional powwows not listed above.
Requests along with powwow flyer should be sent directly to the Ojibwemowin Enokijig Coordinator two weeks prior to date of powwow
7. Royalty must wear crown/sash at Mille Lacs State of the Band Address and may volunteer to represent NASS/Pine Grove at any other Mille Lacs Band events, regalia is optional, a notice will be sent home with all Royalty
8. It is strongly recommended that royalty attend seasonal ceremonial dances whenever possible
9. If any Royalty transfers to another school, he/she must give up their title to the first runner up
10. Royalty crowns are valued at \$1,000.00. Royalty crowns must be returned to NASS Ojibwemowin Enokijig upon completion of reign; students may keep the sash
11. Parents and/or guardians, please keep a copy of these requirements and responsibilities for yourself and student
